

Comments by the BHCAG on the Submissions**Of Margaret Maisey**

1. Page 0001 – para 2, It is inconceivable that Ms Maisey had no awareness of the problems before January 1995. The reasons being are as follows:-
 - a) Ms Maisey was in daily contact with nursing supervisors who would pass to her knowledge acquired;
 - b) The nursing staff, on the ward, were concerned. This is confirmed by the evidence of parents and the comments made to them by the ward staff;
 - c) The evidence of Rachel Ferris;
 - d) The statement of Dr Swayne who although only a junior and dealing with paediatrics for a very short period, was aware of the concerns being expressed about paediatric cardiac surgery. See page two of Dr Swayne's letter of 22 December 1999.
