DIAGNOSIS: Atrioventricular defect
 Down's syndrome

This baby presents clinically to Truro in heart failure and has done so on a frequent number of occasions. Investigation confirms the anatomy of the defect with the one comment that the anatomy of the inter-atrial septum may be a little unusual possibly encouraging diversion of IVC blood to the LA. The calculations suggest pulmonary vascular resistance is 4.7 on 40% oxygen, falling to 4.2 on 100% oxygen with Qp/Qs of 3.4 rising to 4.1/1.

It was agreed that he should have total correction and that his risk was somewhat elevated on account of the level of pulmonary vascular resistance. For this reason it was felt that the operation should be carried out as quickly as was reasonably possible. I will therefore make arrangements for Matthew to see me as urgently as possible in outpatients, in any case hopefully not later than the beginning of January. The child should be scheduled for surgery if at all possible in January 1994.
