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due to congestive cardiac failure, but no other abnormality.

To the best of my knowledge no cardiac pacemaker remains in the body.

Histology

Sections of the heart show mild endocardial thickening and recent sub-endocardial ischaemic necrosis.

Sections of lung show focal intraalveolar haemorrhage and thickening of the muscular walls of pulmonary arteries suggesting grade I pulmonary hypertension.

Microbiology

Blood cultures have yielded no growth.

Conclusion

These findings are consistent with the previously stated cause of death.
