Further to the recent correspondence from Bristol about Amy's admission for catheterisation, she and her parents came to see me in the Outpatients today.

As you know, she has Fallots tetralogy with fairly mild cyanosis at the present time. Her anatomy is such, however, that there is severe pulmonary stenosis and it is likely that she will need enlargement of the pulmonary valve and pulmonary artery in order to relieve the obstruction. I have advised the parents that we should decided in principle to correct this condition and had a full discussion about the potential risks and benefits involved. They have accepted this advice and her name will be placed on the waiting list. If her condition remains as it is at present, the operation is likely to be in 6-12 months from now. Should her cyanosis worsen, then of course that date would be brought forward. It is important, therefore that she should be kept under regular review and an appointment has been made for 3 months to see Dr Martin here.
