HISTORY
INVESTIGATIONS
AND TREATMENT:**DEAR DOCTOR**

Danyele is a one year old child with transposition who had a balloon atrial septostomy in the first few days of life on two occasions. Subsequently, he had been well though he has been dyspnoeic on feeding at times and remains somewhat cyanosed.

Post operatively, Danyele did well although he had two episodes of SVT and for this he was digitalised. He was extubated on the 4th November and came over to us on the 5th when he was still having inotropic support. Oxygen requirement was only 30% initially and he was not unduly tachypnoeic.

Progress: Inotropes were weaned over the next 48 hours and antibiotics stopped after five days. He had some problems of hypokalaemia but this improved with replacement. He had no further problems with SVT and the chest drain was removed on the 6th November.

By the 9th November he was feeding well and was discharged home on the 13th November.

Drugs on discharge; Digoxin 30 micrograms bd. Frusemide 8 mg. bd. Potassium chloride 8 mmols bd. He was to be seen in outpatients in one months time.
