

## ACTION

- 4.2 Partial transfer of childrens work from BRI to BCH option - Rejected

The transfer may be possible as a first step to total transfer to BCH but in the short term would cause considerable problems with medical manpower needs and the required structural alterations at BCH which may not then accommodate a final move. Discussion took place on the number of theatre sessions at BRI used for children, 5 or 6?

- 4.3 Total transfer of childrens service to BCH option - Agreed

BRI implications - freed space would allow adult work to increase to 830 cases per year.

BCH implications

- ITU beds. Within present ITU there is space for 1 further bed therefore requirement is for space for 3 extra beds funding for 4 extra beds.
- Theatres. Provision of additional theatre to provide 5/6 extra sessions making 7/8 in all?

- 4.4 Adult work at BRI to increase to 1040 cases per year - Agreed

Theatre sessions. If 830 cases use 17 sessions then 1040 cases require 21.

- 4.5 Adult work increase to 1040 and retain paediatric work at BRI at 1990 level.

Adult work level agreed.

Paediatric workload may increase but difficult to estimate, particularly the effect of the planned unit in Cardiff on South Wales patients now treated in Bristol, ie rate and speed of withdrawal.

- 4.6 Increase of Cardiology to support increase in adult Cardiac Surgery - Agreed.
