ACTION

Mr McKinlay asked how the Trust could identify the relevant professional standards and compare local performance. He commented that few of the audits concerned outcome.

Dr Bullimore explained the difficulty of publishing national standards and there was often no clear consensus in the medical profession.

The committee agreed that audit needed to be incorporated into the management process and gave support to Dr Bullimore in trying to achieve this aim. Professor Dixon drew attention to a workshop on clinical effectiveness which he had attended. A briefing paper for this purpose to be circulated with the minutes.
