As you know, Mr de Leval sent me a copy of his letter to you of 13 September in my capacity as President of the BMA.

I have to say that I was astounded to hear that Mr Dhasmana had been asked to give up his paediatric cardiac surgery. I was aware that the review conducted by Mr de Leval and Dr Hunter this year exonerated Mr Dhasmana from any hint of professional incompetence with regard to his paediatric cardiac surgery. It does seem therefore completely unjust that he should be treated in this way which will inevitably be seen by the local community as evidence that he was indeed incompetent at his job.

I hope therefore that you will include me in your reply to Mr de Leval as, like him, I believe that this is something which ought to be taken up at the highest possible level.
