1. To improve clinical effectiveness for the benefit of patients within available financial and manpower resources
2. To develop and disseminate a strategy for multi-disciplinary clinical audit within UBHT clinical directorates
3. To develop an efficient and accessible system, using available information technology, to collect and collate data for the benefit of;
  - a) Healthcare professionals within the Trust
  - b) The Trust Board
  - c) The Purchasing Authorities
    - i) through the presentation of the Annual Report
    - ii) by providing a means of response to specific areas of concern raised by the Commissioners
4. To be a resource to facilitate clinical audit locally, regionally and nationally
5. To integrate clinical audit with Quality Assurance and R & D initiatives, in order to:
  - a) Set standards
  - b) Develop outcome measures
  - c) Monitor performance
